

By reason of the necessity to prevent unfair publishing practices, the Editorial Board of the *e-Almanac Space and Time* notify that

since June 1, 2017, following actions of the authors are considered unacceptable:

1. **Almanac self-citations:** citing in the article submitted to *e-Almanac Space and Time* any works published here earlier, including articles by authors themselves. **Such (published earlier in e-Almanac) works could be quoted no more than 1 per article.** The number of articles quoted in *e-Almanac* published in the print journal, and vice versa, number of articles quoted in print journal published earlier in *e-Almanac* cannot exceed **three works** for the entire list of references;

2. **Self-citations of Authors:** citing in the article submitted to *e-Almanac Space and Time* any works by the author/each of the co-authors of the article (including those in another co-authorship) published earlier ever and somewhere. **Such (published earlier) works can be cited no more than 2 per article** (for any number of quoted sources);

3. **Republishing text published earlier (compiled from works published earlier) and available on the Internet (self-plagiarism) in amount exceeding 10% of the total volume of the article.** In the event that author does not give references to these 10%, such republishing will be considered as plagiarism.
